Paragraph 1: Topic Selection *Describe how you chose your topic.*

- What did you include in your project to try to engage your audience and introduce the topic?
- What choices did you make about information to include or not include about your subject?
- What was the most important part of your presentation?

Paragraph 4: Theme *Explain how your project relates to the NHD Theme.*

Paragraph 5: What was the best part of this process for you? What did you struggle with most?

For all categories but websites, put a page break in after the last paragraph and past your entire annotated bibliography in.
